RE: Idaho Online Insurance Verification Changes to Idaho Insurance Verification System (IdahoIVS)
DATE: June 28, 2023

Idaho's current mandatory insurance reporting system, Online Insurance Verification System, (OIVS) for the Division of Motor Vehicles will be changing. Idaho DMV will be transitioning over the next few months to the Idaho Insurance Verification System (IdahoIVS).

IdahoIVS will be able to perform real-time insurance verification and improve the uninsured identification process. This transition will require all insurance companies authorized to sell motor vehicle liability insurance to register with the new system. Beginning June 30, 2023, the IdahoIVS system is available to insurance companies for registration, testing, and production integration.

Key Dates:

July 31, 2023 is the deadline to register on the IdahoIVS website.

September 30, 2023 is the deadline for companies to begin testing. Insurance companies must submit a test BOB file to IdahoIVS and begin web services testing.

December 1, 2023 is the deadline for insurance companies to move to production with IdahoIVS making their production web services available (if applicable) and begin BOB data submissions.

IdahoIVS utilizes the Insurance Industry Committee on Motor Vehicle Administration (IICMVA) standards for insurance company reporting.

More information is available in the guide attached. Idaho Code section 49-1234 requires all insurance companies authorized to sell motor vehicle insurance in Idaho to report their Book of Business (BOB), and effective July 1, 2023, this must be done weekly. Until complete implementation, insurers must continue to report the BOB to the OIVS in the interim.
